SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Governor Whitmer signed executive order [2020-59](#), extending her “Stay Home, Stay Safe” order through May 15. The new order states that individuals must wear homemade face coverings when they enter enclosed public spaces for those who are medically able to tolerate it. It will also lift some restrictions on outdoor activities and allow some workers who perform previously suspended activities to go back to work.
- Governor Whitmer also signed executive order [2020-60](#), where grocery stores and pharmacies must create at least two (2) hours per week of dedicated shopping time for vulnerable populations. Additionally, requiring checkout employees and any individual who enters a food-selling establishment or pharmacy and is able to medically tolerate a face covering to wear a covering over his or her nose and mouth.
- Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has launched a training program for general contact tracing to prepare volunteers for assisting and completing contact calls for persons who have been exposed to COVID-19. This will help play a big role in re-opening the economy by maintaining containment and continuing mitigation.
- Michigan’s Coronavirus website has launched [Robin](#), a virtual assistant to help answer questions about COVID-19.
- The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has authorized the first COVID-19 diagnostic test with a home collection option. Patients will self-swab to collect a nasal sample, then they mail it in an insulated package to a LabCorp lab for testing. In the coming weeks, LabCorp intends to make these COVID-19 Test home collection kits available to consumers in most states, with a doctor’s order.
